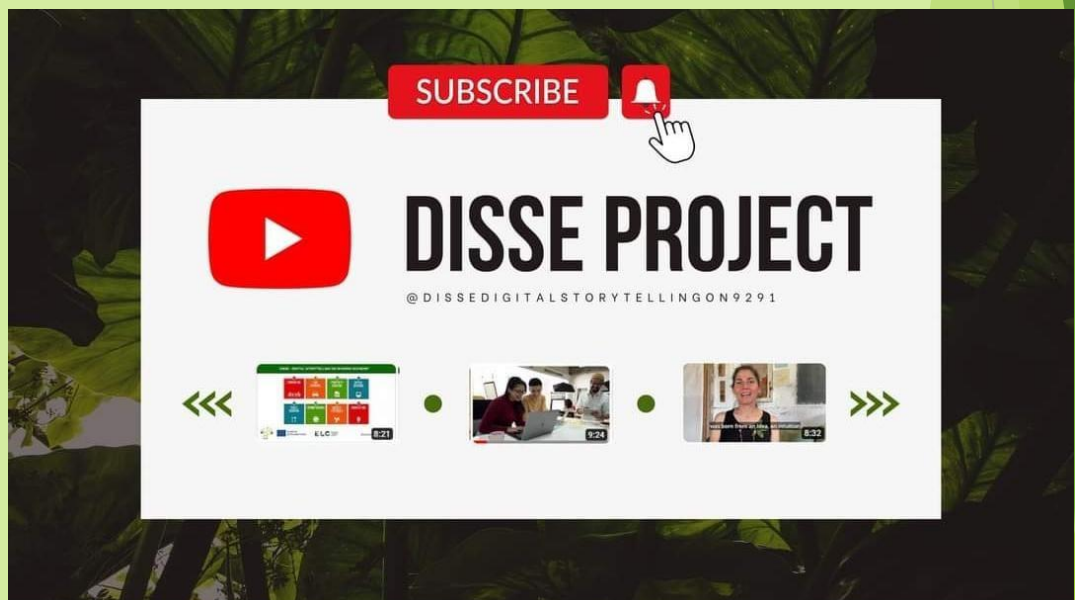

## DISSE project and sharing economy

As you may remember, DISSE stands for Digital Storytelling on Sharing Economy, and its main objective is to introduce the concept of shared economy to secondary schools through digital storytelling. The sharing economy is based on the idea that multiple individuals can benefit from a single good, eliminating the need to purchase or own something when it can be borrowed or lent. In today's society, consumption is often the primary means of meeting our needs, but this approach is not sustainable as it leads to acquiring more than we actually require. It is therefore important to teach students from a young age to share their belongings with others. Sharing, however, extends beyond objects and material possessions; it also includes sharing time, knowledge, and skills.

## Work in progress

After the Learning Teaching Training Activities (LTTA) and the meeting in Ubrique (Spain) in February 2023, the DISSE partners started working on result 2, namely the Digital Storytelling Classrooms Toolkit.
